Downtown Winnsboro, SC March 6, 2009

The Fairfield County Museum joins Downtown Winnsboro, the Fairfield Chamber of Commerce, The Fairfield County Arts Council, South Carolina Arts Commission, and other downtown businesses to present a fabulous First Friday experience on March 6, 2009.



Beginning at 6 PM, in the Museum backyard at 231 S. Congress St. will be the location of a Ceilidh (pronounced *kay lee*), a traditional Gaelic social celebration originating in Ireland and Scotland. We'll celebrate our community's Scots Irish heritage with fiddlers, country dancers, balladeers, bagpipes and drums.

Also, come join forces the next morning (Mar. 7) with descendants of an early Scottish family (the McCreights) in rebuilding their ancestor's 1770 log barn at the Museum. Find out how our early American predecessors used broad axes, adzes, froes, and treenails to build their homes and farm buildings.
